Exploring Personal Experience Narratives of Racial and Gendered Discrimination and Leadership Progress in Midwifery and Healthcare, through Riessman's Thematic Approach

The two-day workshop will analyze three Personal Experience Narratives from UK NHS healthcare leaders using Riessman's dialogic thematic approach and other narrative frameworks. It will address societal issues like disparities in midwifery care for Black women and career inequalities for Black healthcare professionals. The narratives expose exclusion and discrimination affecting these leaders' experiences and will be examined through various leadership theories, including 'trait' theory and compassionate, inclusive models.
